

Garter Cable Poncho

Materials: 600 yds worsted weight yarn (3 balls Plymouth Encore Worsted)

> Size 10 ½ Needles Cable Stitch Holder Darning Needle Crochet hook

Gauge approx: 4 stitches per inch

Make 2 rectangles according to sizing chart below.

CAST ON 36(40, 44, 48, 52, 56, 60, 64)

Row 1: (Wrong side) K 14(16/18/20/22/24/26/28), P8, K 14(16/18/20/22/24/26/28)

Row 2: K12(14/16/18/20/22/24/26), P2, K8, P2, K12(14/16/18/20/22/24/26)

Row 3 and all odd rows: Repeat row 1

Row 4: K12(14/16/18/20/22/24/26), P2, Cable 4 Front*, P2, K12(14/16/18/20/22/24/26)


Row 5 - 11: Repeat rows 1 to 3 twice, and Row 1 once more.

Repeat from row 4, making the cable row every 8th row, until piece is twice as long as it is wide. Bind off in knit on right side (row 8), 4 rows after last cable. To count your rows, find the hole next to the last cable. You should be able to count 8 strands before the next time you make the cable.

Sew rectangles together with darning needle as in diagram. Cut fringe 2 x desired length, plus 1". Using 2 strands, fold in half & use a crochet hook to attach to bottom edges.





*Cable 4 Front: Place next 4 stitches on a cable stitch holder and hang in front of work, K next 4 stitches, place 4 held stitches back on the left needle, then knit them.
