

Tranqwool* Seaweed Scarf

Finished size: Approx 5" x 8 feet long!

Size J/10 (6mm) Crochet Hook

1—100gm Hank Plymouth Yarn Passion Nette, approx 30 yds

Start by making a tight overhand knot close to the end of the Passion Nette, picture A. Spread open nette, then work slip stitches along upper edge of nette (row 1), each stitch approx 1" apart as in picture B, continuing along top edge as in picture C.



A: Overhand knot at beginning and end

When Scarf is approx 1/2 of desired length, (do this when 15 yds remain or sooner for a shorter scarf), fold nette around back of finished section (row 1). Now begin row 2 by slip stitching as before, approx 1 inch apart, attaching row 2 to row 1 as in picture D. Picture E shows the two rows in progress.



B: Slip stitch along upper edge

When 1 stitch remains, trim Passion Nette approx 3" long, then pull tail through final stitch on hook. Make a tight overhand knot, very close to the final stitch. Trim end.

It is possible to work additional rows if desired, but you will need more yarn, or make a shorter scarf.
