

GALWAY ROVING **Cable Drop Stitch Cowl**



Approximate Measurements:
8” wide, 36” circumference

Materials:

Galway Roving:

3—100G balls, color 91 Orange

Gauge: 10 sts, 14 rows= 4” in st st on US Size 15 (10mm) needles,
13 sts= 4” in cable stitch on US Size 15 (10mm) needles.

Needles/Notions: US Size 15 (10mm) straight knitting needles, 1 cable needle.

Begin

CO 26 sts.

Setup Row (WS): P 1 row.

Row 2 (RS): K8, *p1, k8; rep from * once more.

Row 3: P8, *k1, p8; rep from * once more.

Row 4: same as row 2.

Row 5: Same as row 3.

Row 6: C4B, *p1, C4B; rep from * once more.

Row 7: Same as row 3.



Row 8: same as row 2.

Row 9: same as row 3.

Rep rows 2-9 until there are approximately 2 yards of yarn left, end having worked a WS Row.

Next row (RS): K8, *sl the next st on the left hand needle off the needle and unravel it a couple rows, pick up the top-most bar between the sts with the left hand needle and k this st (Note: no sts were dec'd), k8; rep from * once more. BO on next row in p. Gently unravel the dropped sts all the way down to the CO edge. Sew the CO and BO edges together, making sure there isn't a twist. Weave in all ends. Block gently if necessary.

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
